



REMARKS


All instruments play without vibrato throughout, unless otherwise indicated.

The instruments are written in their customary transpositions (indicated at first appearance).

duration : ca. 18 min.

- n : niente
- N : normal fingering
-  : accelerando
-  : ritardando
-  : repeat the given note(s) during the indicated duration
-  : one quarter-tone sharp
-  : three quarter-tones sharp
-  : one quarter-tone flat
-  : short fermata
-  : normal fermata
-  : long fermata
-  : - winds: flatterzunge
- other instruments: tremolando
-  : reversed tonguing quick forward movement of the tongue at the end of a note
-  : pronounce the indicated sound ("T" or "P")
-  : aeolian sound (sound with audible breath)
-  : only air
-  : - clarinet: slap-tongue
- strings: Bartok pizzicato
-  : tongue click
-  : "kissing"-effect
-  : unspecified high harmonic (with fingering of the given note), obtained by overblowing.
-  : - clarinet: split sound
- horn: split sound producing a multiphonic of two successive harmonics (see bar 113)
- strings: cracked tone, produced with very high bow pressure
- tamtam + tub., bell: see instructions bar 111
-  : (bar 179) play glissando's, start at free pitch (not lower than the indicated pitch). Play 3-9 double stoppings (always n) of unspecified pitch. Stop the glissando when playing.

lowest position to start glissando



velato: rapid succession of indeterminate notes that cannot be recognized separately (a kind of extension of the glissando).

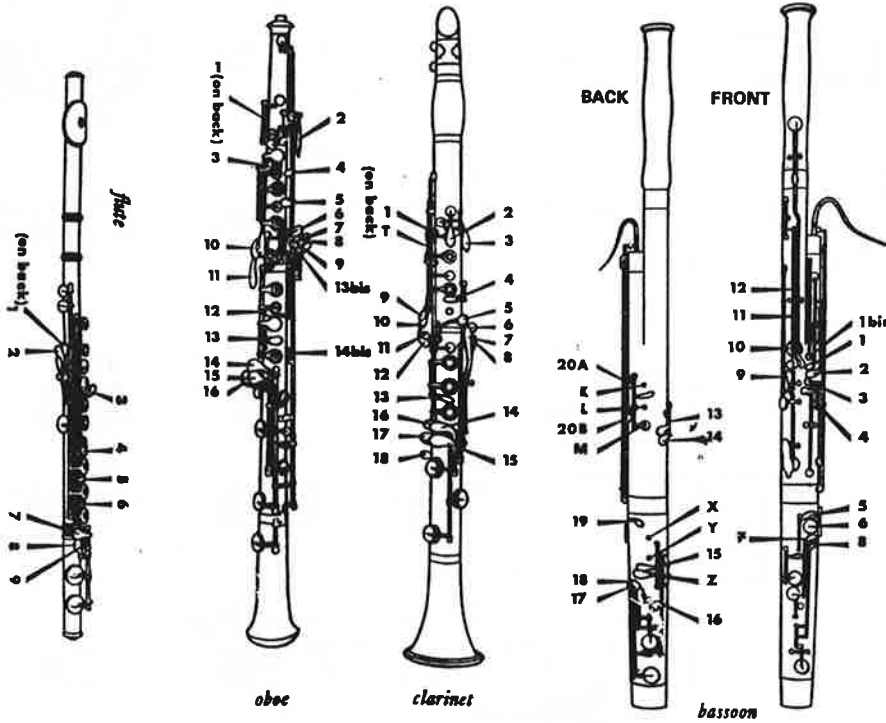
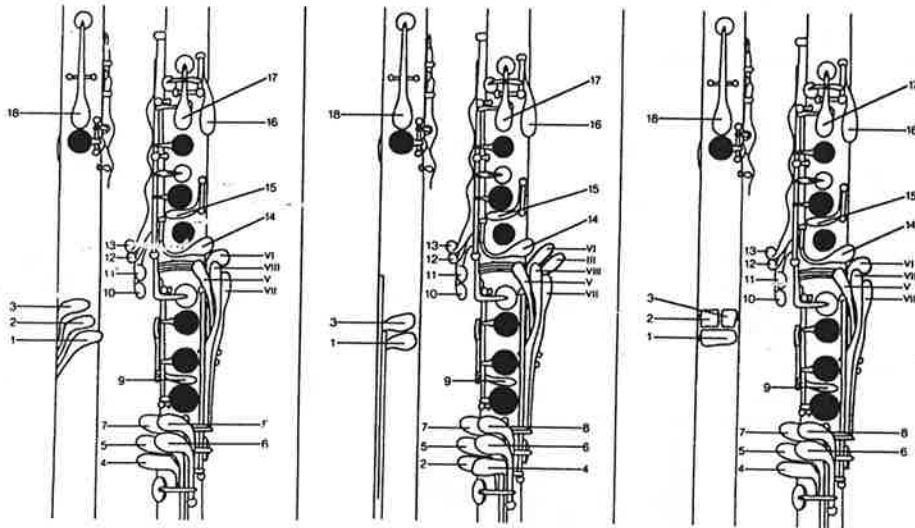
